



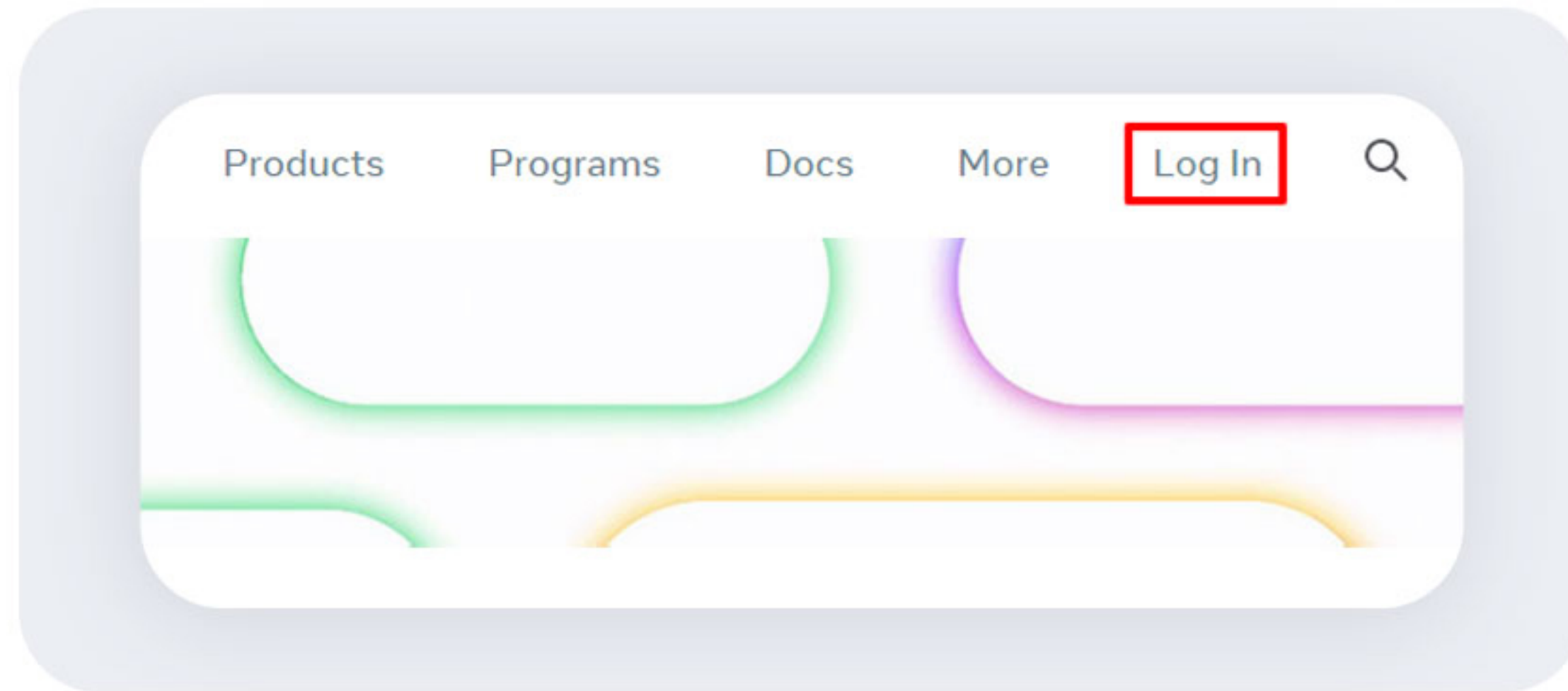

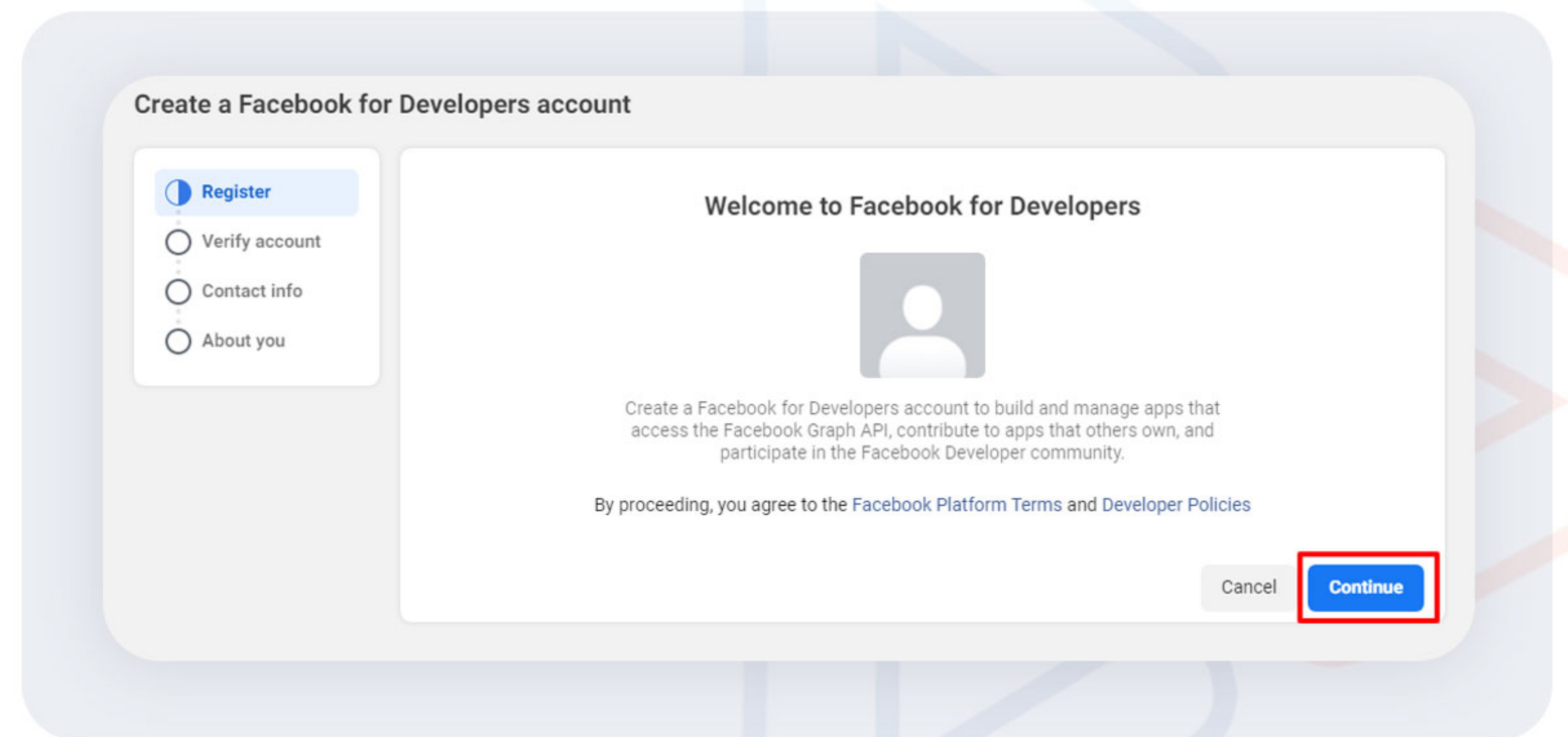
STEP 1

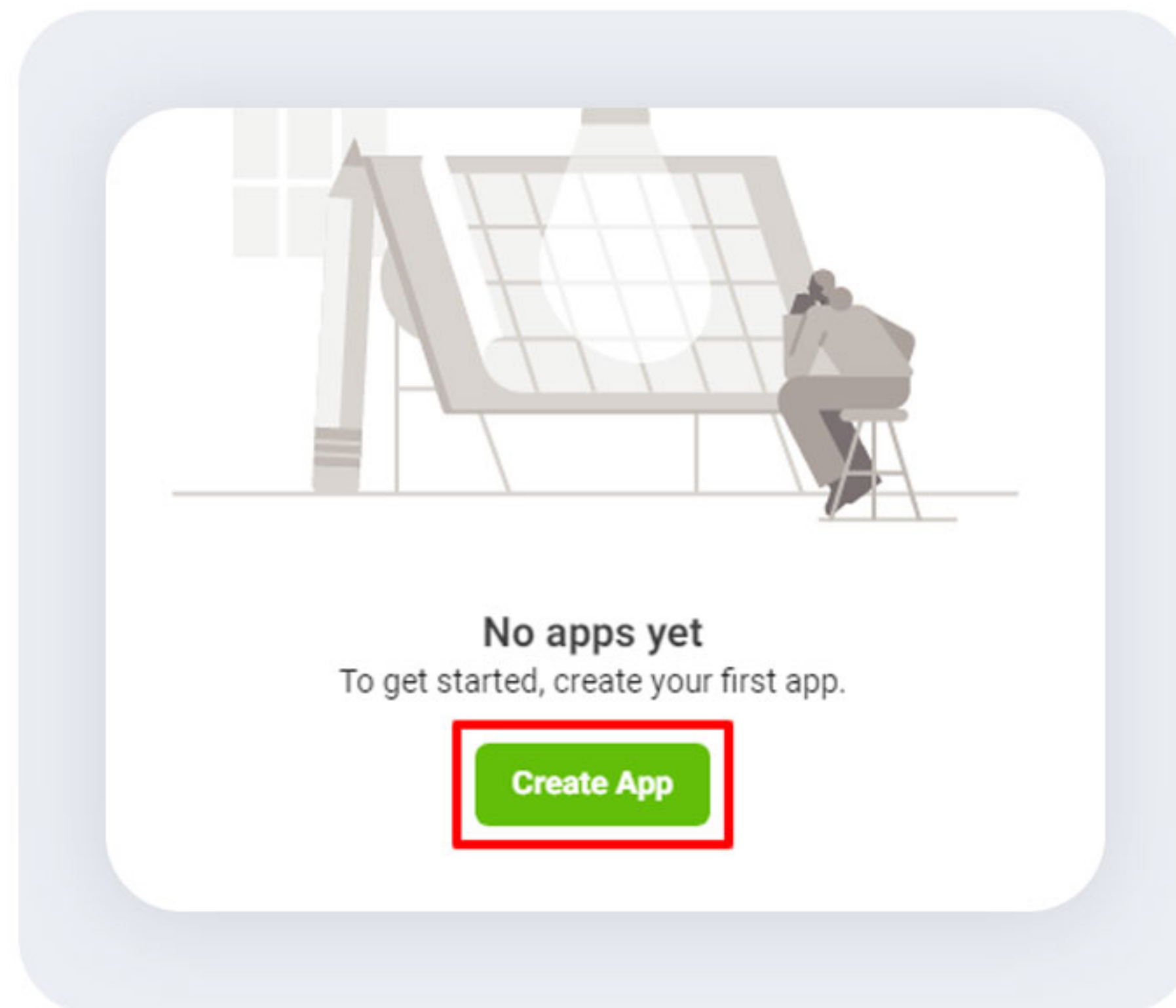

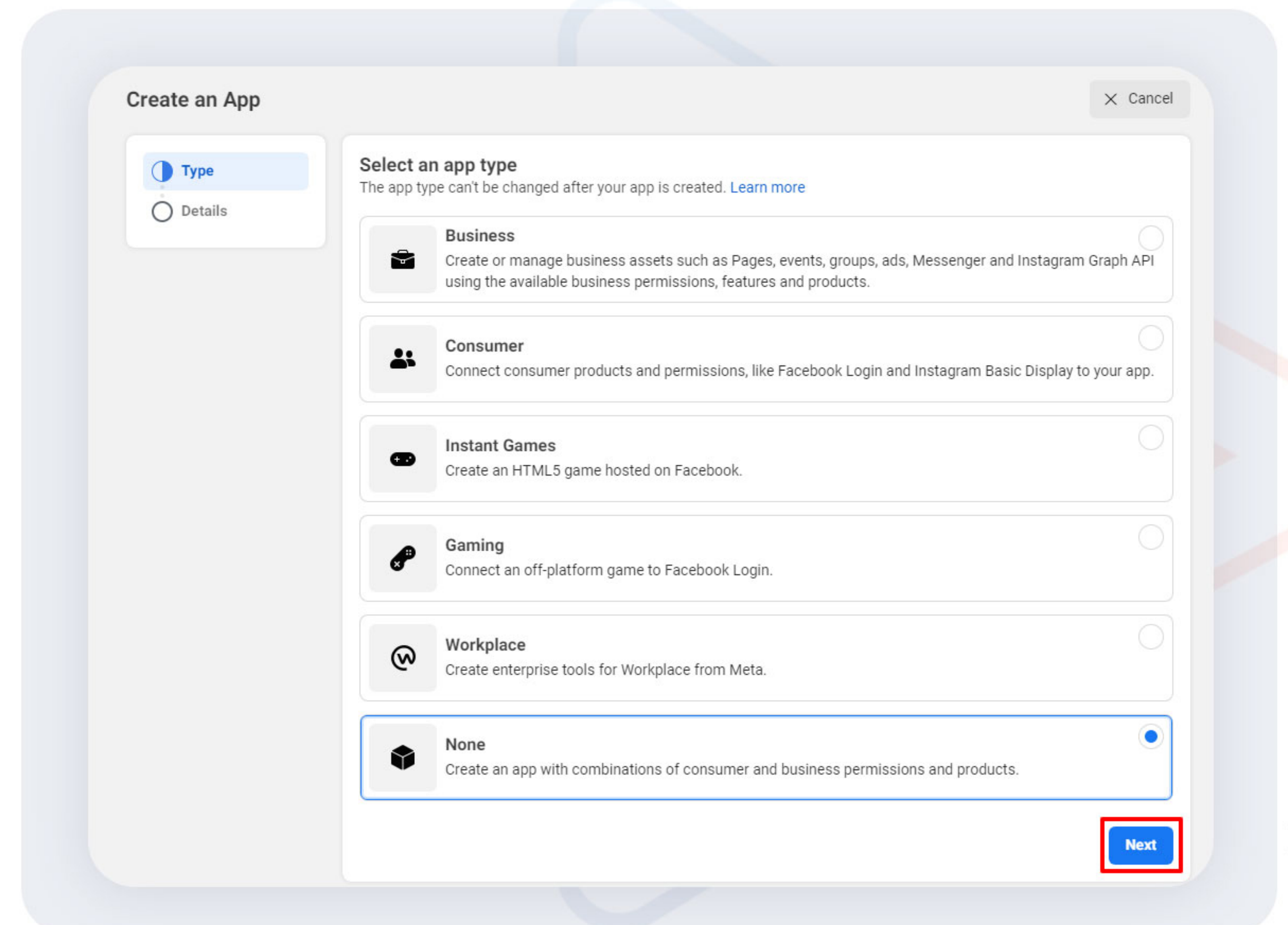
STEP 2

Create an App




Click on the "Create App" button

Process



You'll need to confirm your account by entering your password.



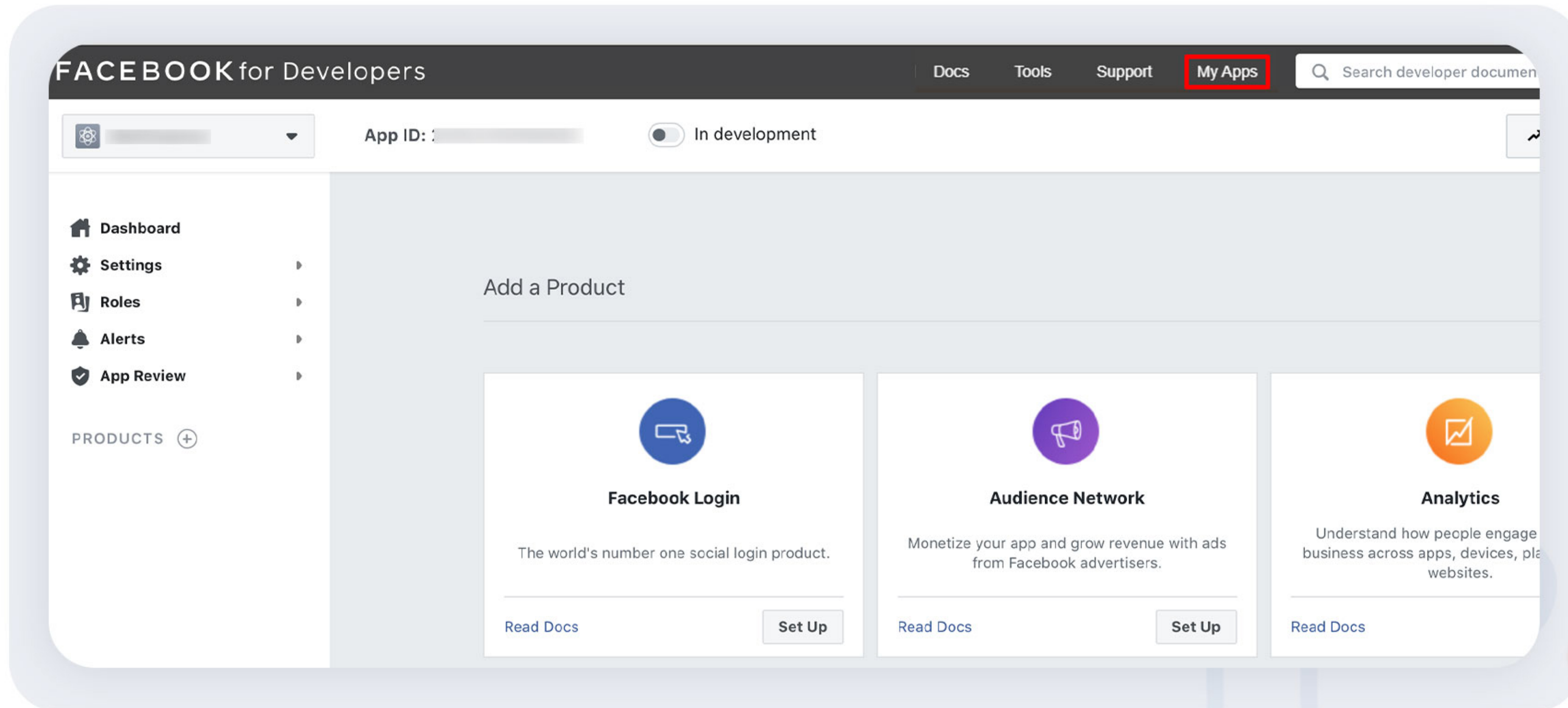

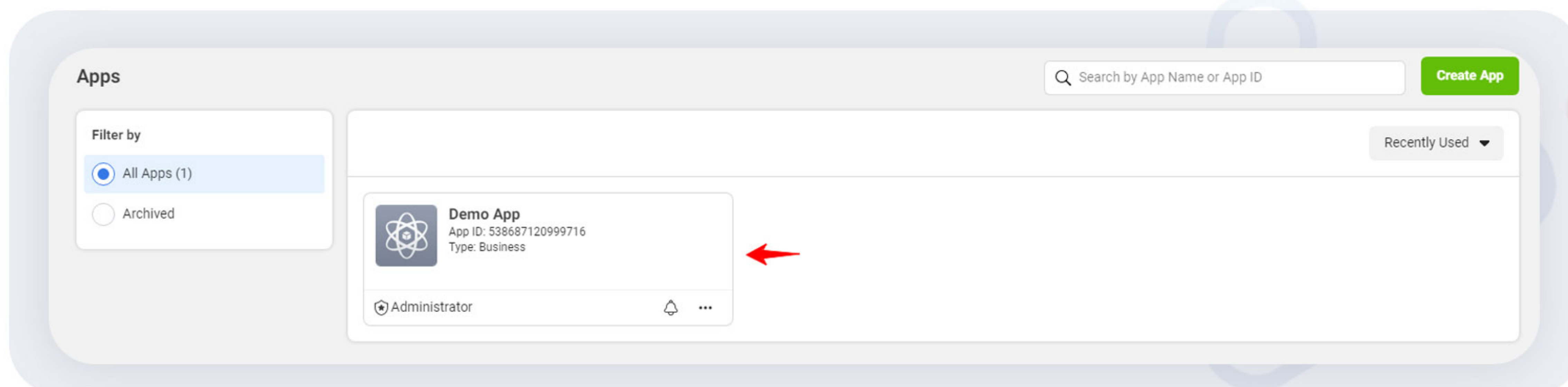
STEP 3

Go into the "My Apps" section

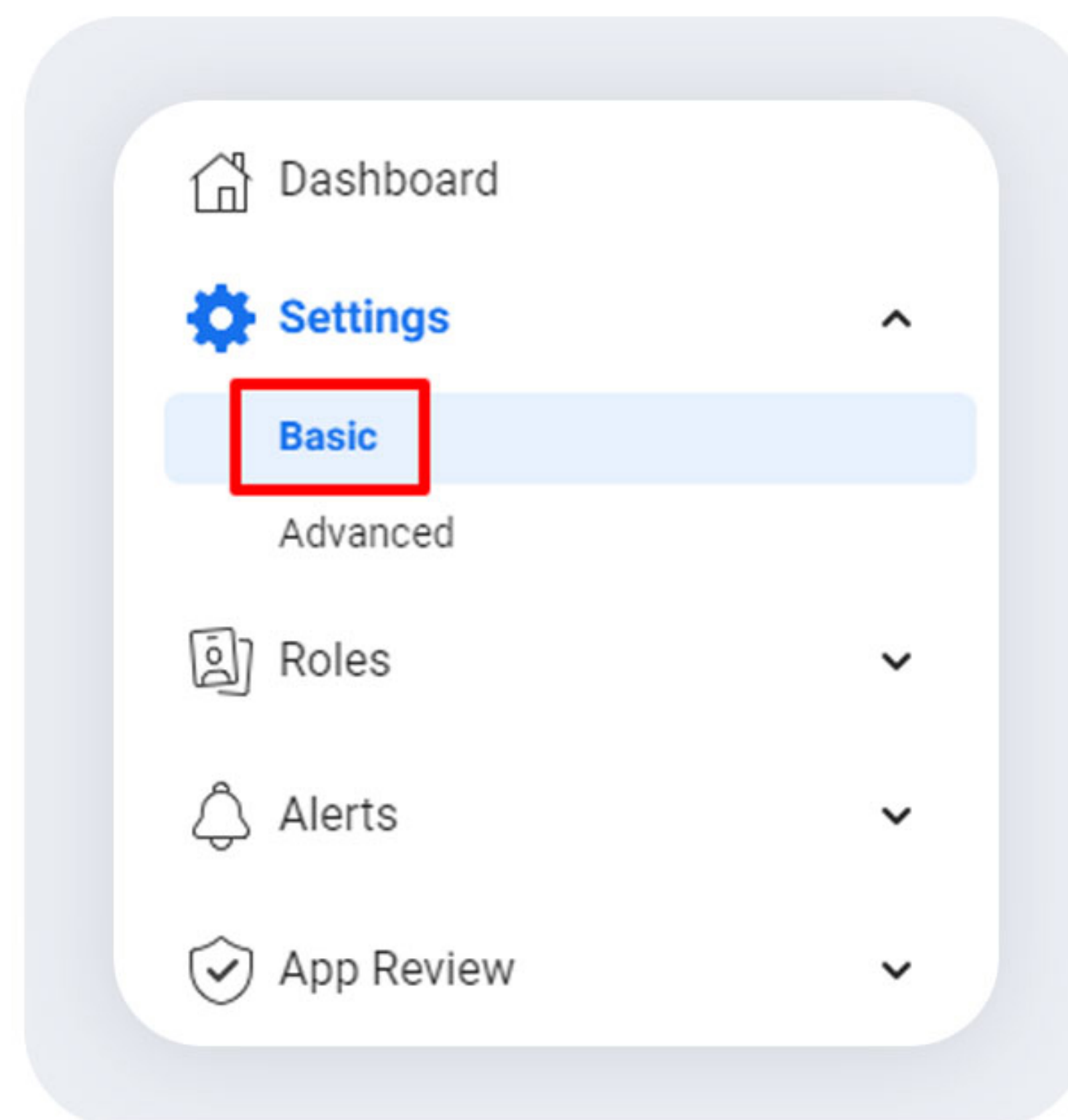
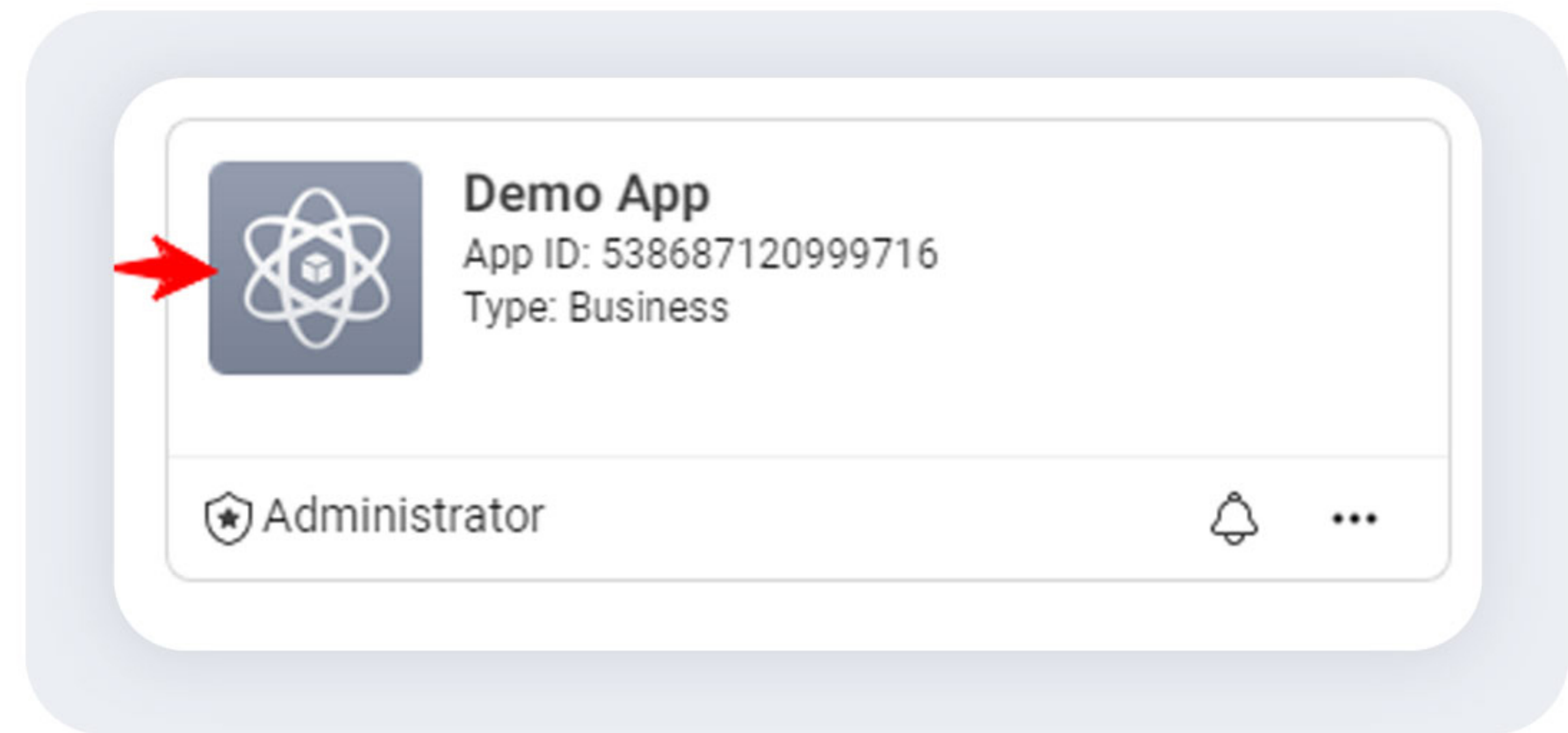


You can see the app which you have created.




Process

- ✓ Then save the changes.

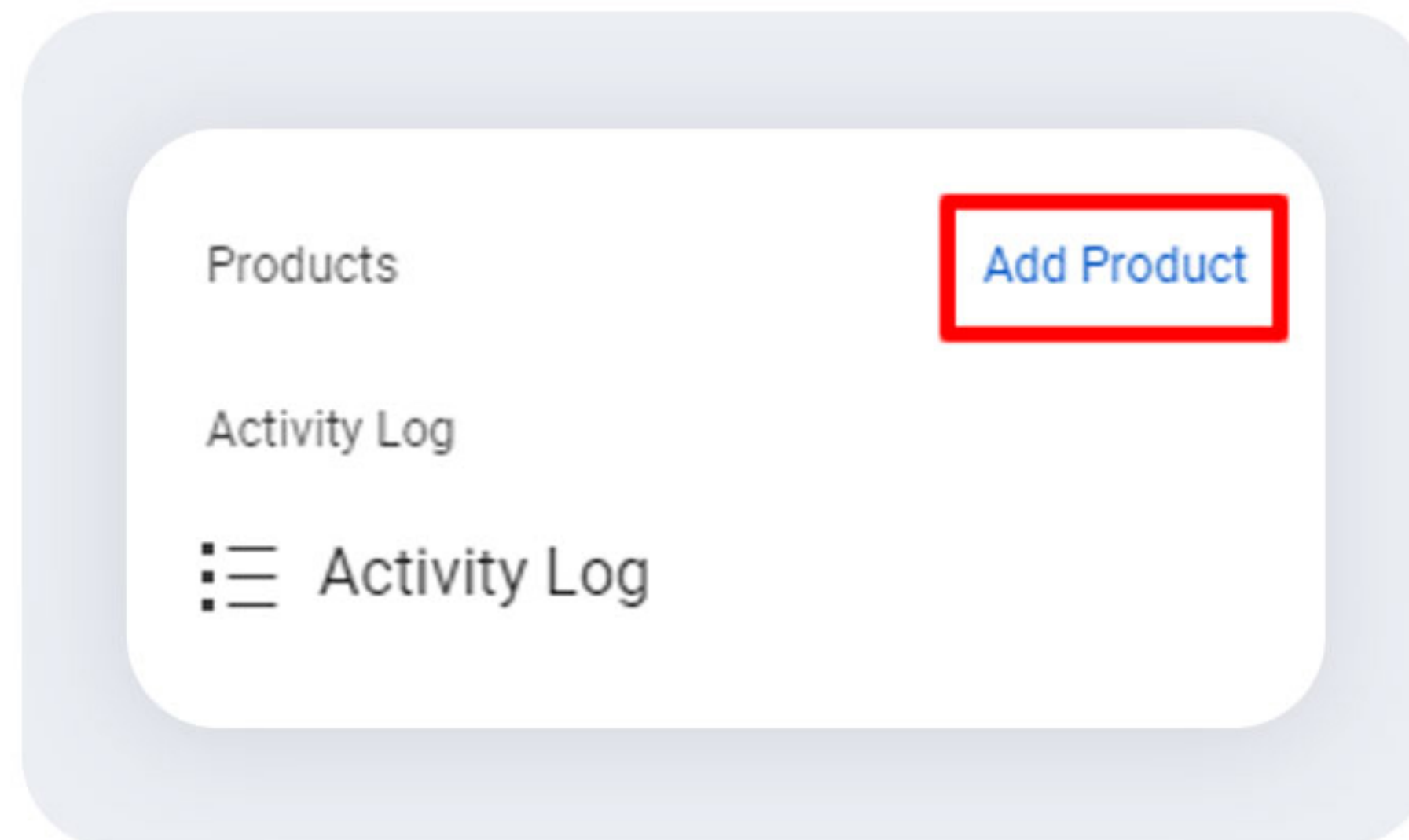
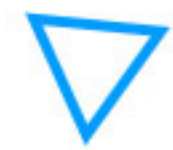
Now you can turn on “Live Mode” according to your preference. Or, you can also continue in the development mode.





STEP 4

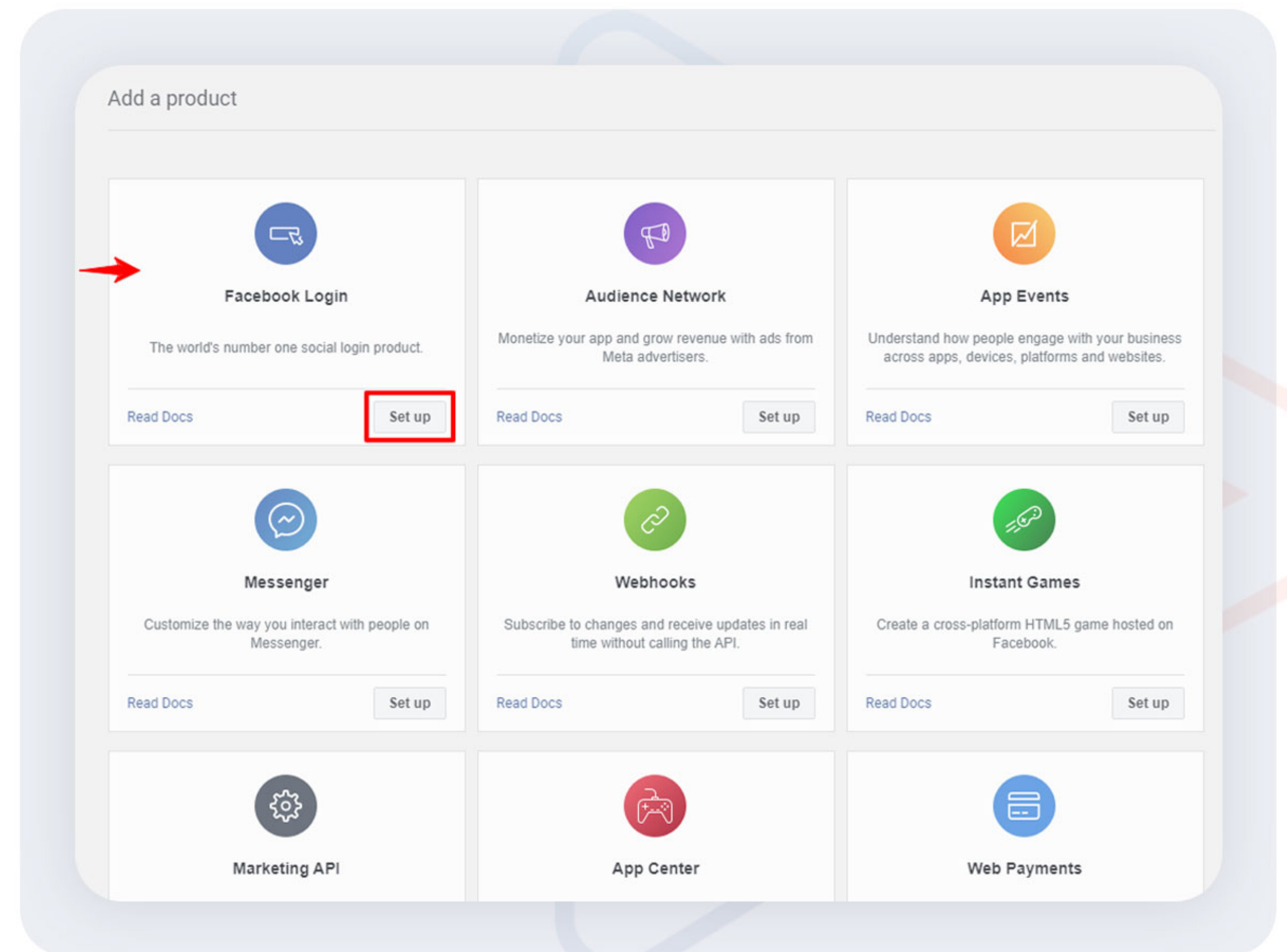
Add Products



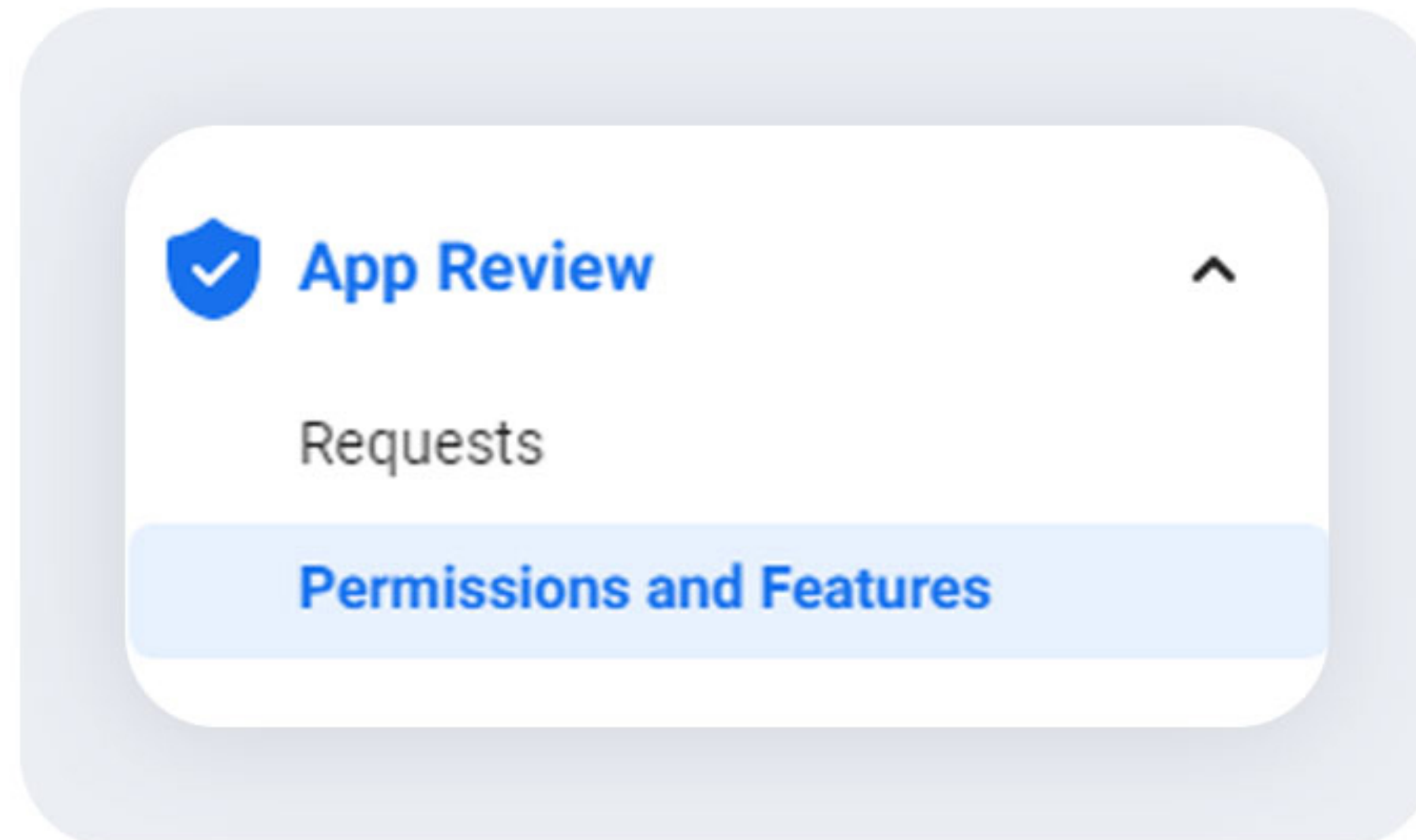
Now go to "Add Product."

- ✓ The product gets added once you click to set up.

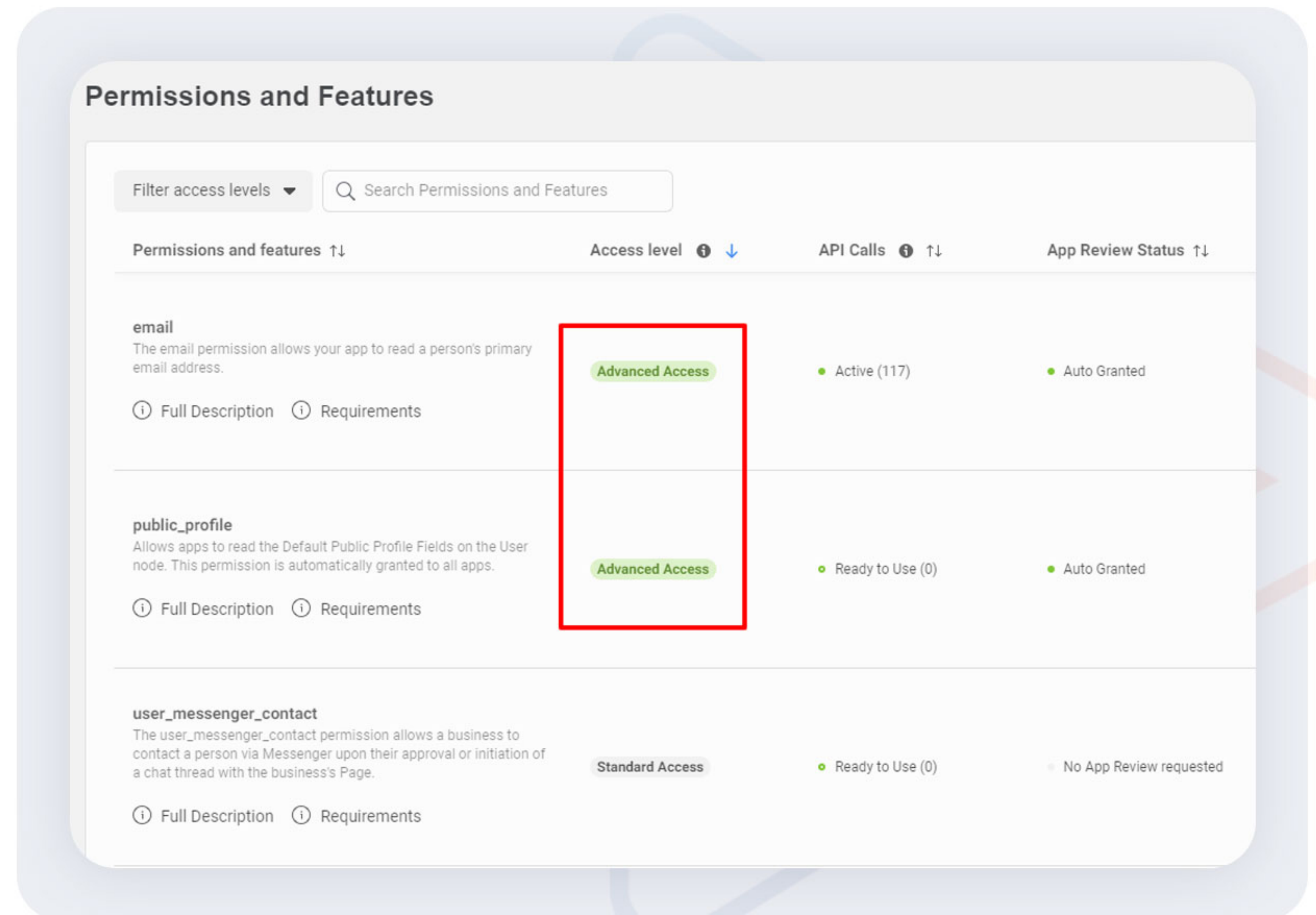


Now you have to request advanced access for the required permissions and features.

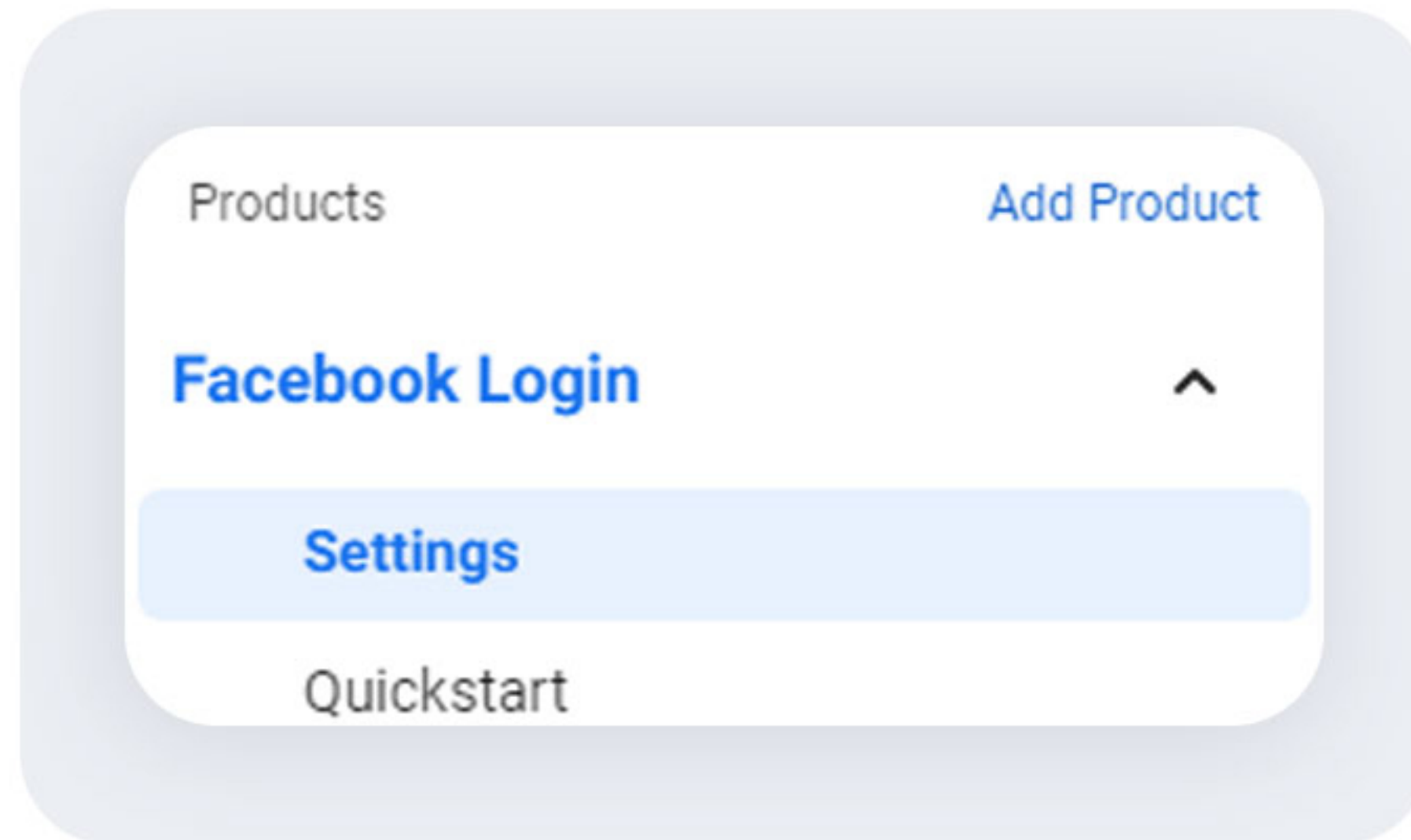


So go to "Permissions and Features" under the "App Review" menu.

Click on the "Request advanced access" to enable the advanced Access.

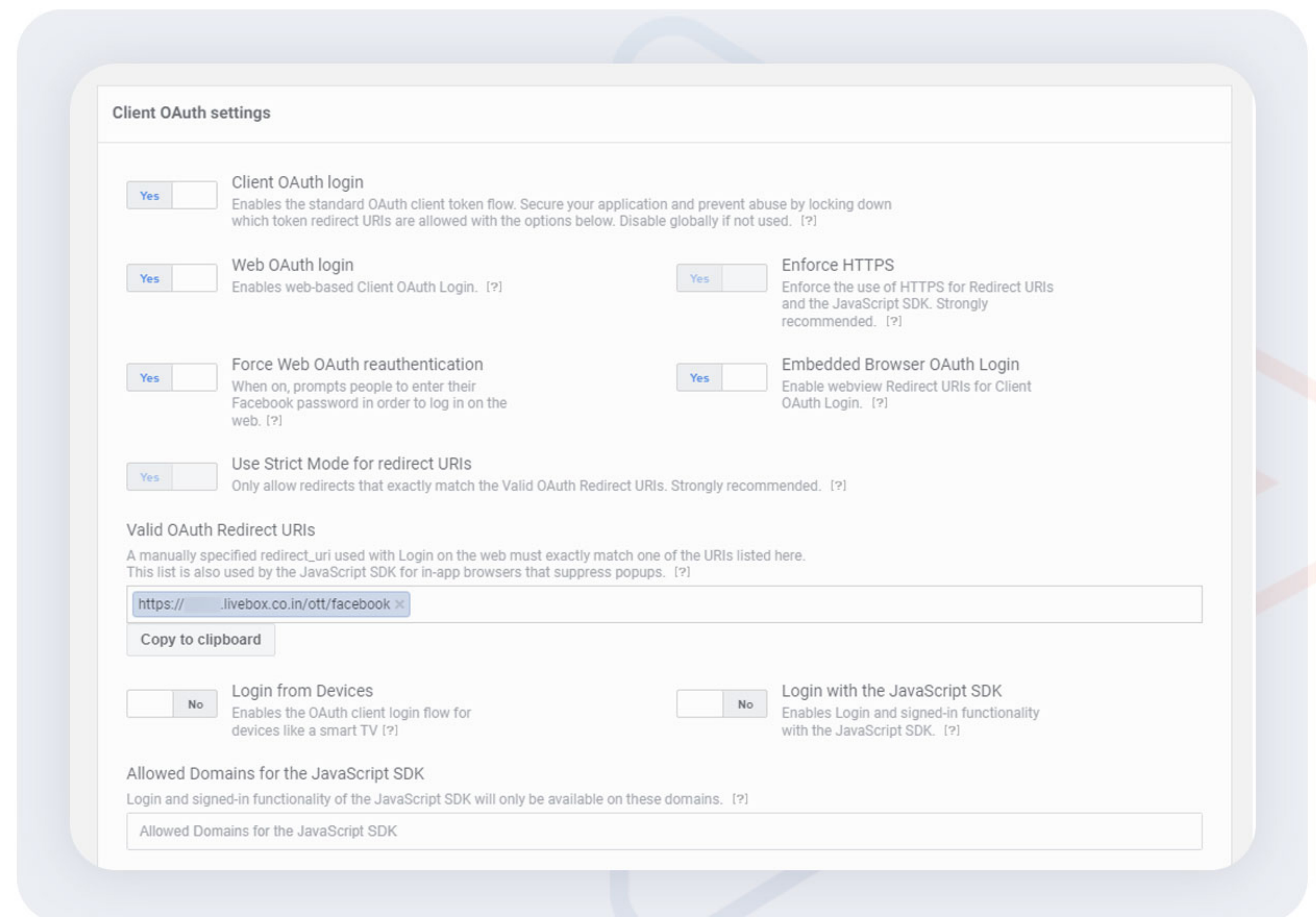


Finally, you have to enable a few Facebook login settings.




So, go to "Settings" under Facebook Login.

- ✓ Enable the required Client OAuth settings according to your preference.
- ✓ Then enter a valid OAuth redirect URI.



Then save the settings

Then you can check whether your URI is valid by entering the redirect URI link.
